During the weeks preceding Christmas, the library opening hours will be:

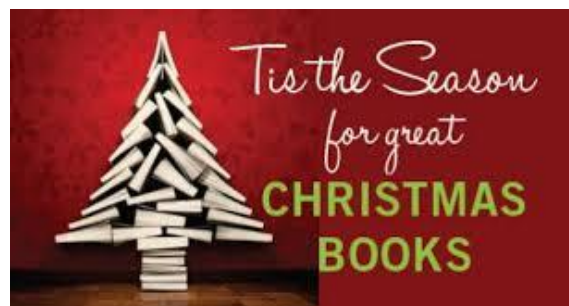
