

TINTINARA AREA SCHOOL

BUS USE POLICY

TOGETHER ACHIEVE SUCCESS

Context

This policy applies to people wishing to access the bus services provided by the Department and managed by Tintinara Area School.

Entitlement

School students whose home address is 5km or more from Tintinara Area School (the school), and who are enrolled at the school, are entitled to travel on the Department Bus Service managed by Tintinara Area School. (Hereafter referred to as the Bus Service.)

Allocation

Students who are entitled to travel on the Bus Service shall have priority when seats are being allocated.

If no room is available then students who are further from the school shall have priority. When room is available seats will be allocated according to the following criteria

- Students attending Tintinara Preschool
- Tintinara Area School students staying with students who are entitled to use the bus service
- Other Tintinara Area School Students
- Tintinara Area School staff
- Other Department students
- Tintinara Area School volunteers

Applications to travel on the bus must be received prior to the date or dates that travel is requested.

Child Protection Issues

All people who are not currently enrolled as students of Tintinara Area School and Preschool shall be required to submit a current Criminal History Check through the Department for Communities and Social Inclusion with their application for permission to travel on the bus.

Permission for Transport of Students on a School Bus

In accordance with the Department for Education *School Transport Policy*, Principals and Education Directors may approve non-entitled students to travel on existing school buses under certain conditions.

following criteria:

- that such approval will not involve the provision of any additional bus service
- that bus routes are not altered to suit the needs of ineligible students
- that the bus has room for the ineligible travellers
- that approval could be withdrawn at short notice if conditions change (for example, if the numbers of eligible travellers increases)
- that such approval is applied for annually, as required.
- If applicable, I will/will not be providing a booster seat for my child/ren before they start using the service.
